

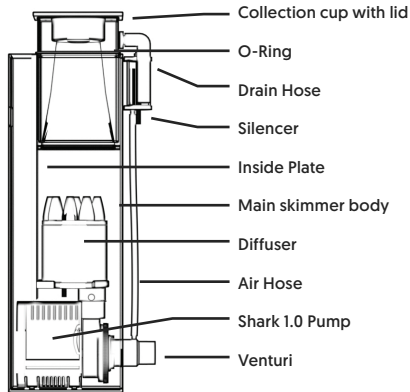


Check Parts

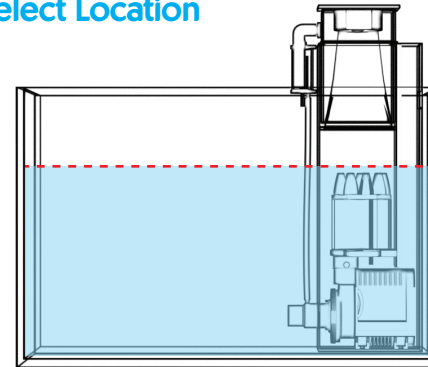
The Media Reactor should be partially assembled when you open the box.

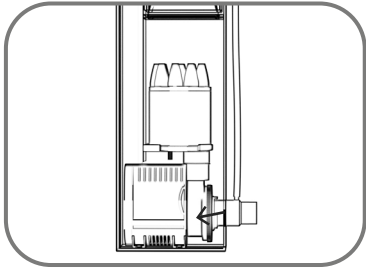
Select Location



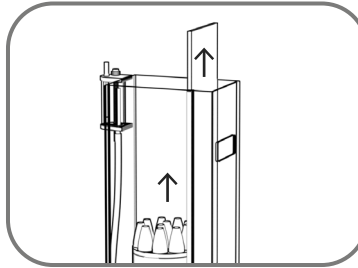
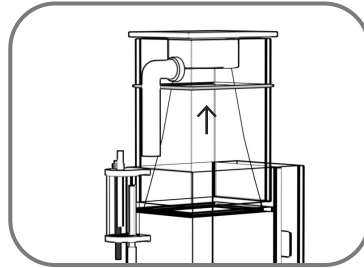
For best results, place skimmer in 8-10" of water. Make sure that skimmer is in no more than 10" of water

The pump must be completely submerged when in use.

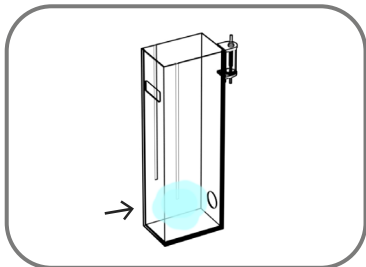
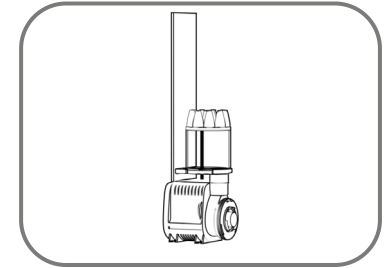
Assembly



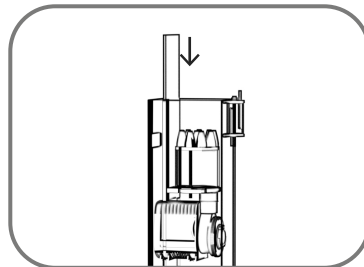
1. Pull out the venturi, and remove the collection cup.



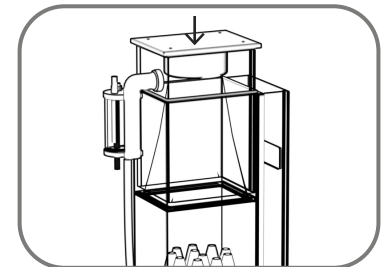
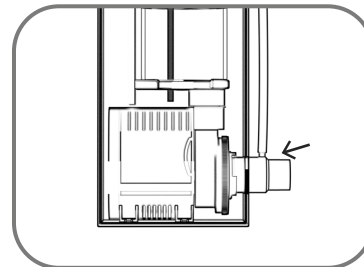
2. Pull out the inside plate and motor assembly and set aside.



3. Remove and discard the bubble wrap.

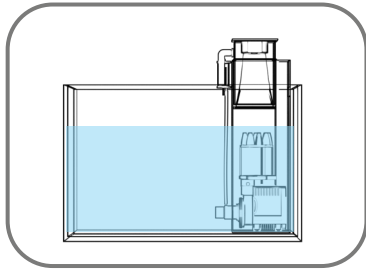


4. Reinstall the inside plate, venturi and collection cup.

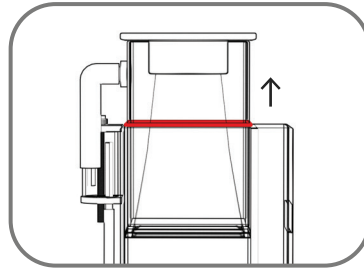




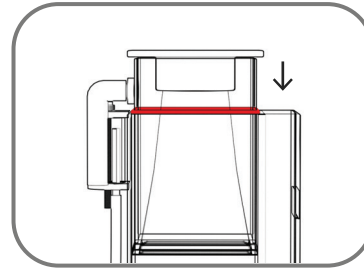
To Start



1. Place the WS-1 into your aquarium or sump then plug in the pump.

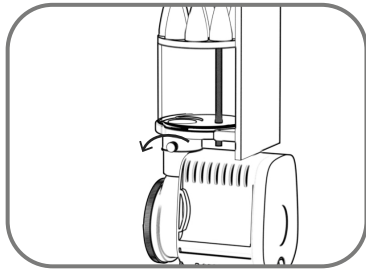


2. The main chamber will fill with bubbles. Carefully adjust the position of the collection cup by changing the position of the O-Ring. If you prefer the skimmate to be lighter lower the cup, and if you prefer it to be darker adjust the cup to be higher.

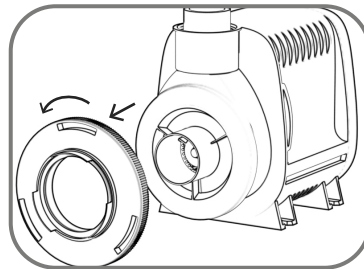


Maintenance

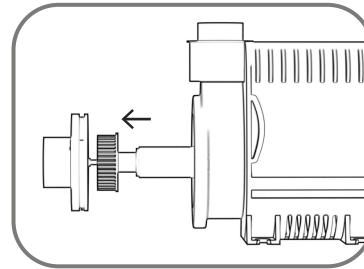
For best performance, clean the collection cup frequently with warm water. Regular maintenance of the pump will ensure a long life and maximum performance (recommended every 3 months). Disassemble the pump through the following steps .



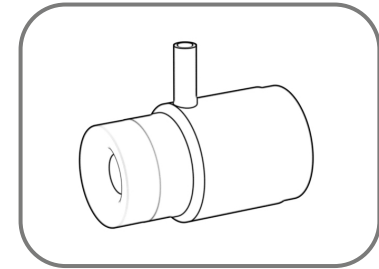
1. Loosen the screw under the diffuser and separate the pump.



2. Remove the cover of the pump



3. Remove the impeller and clean with warm water and aquarium-use toothbrush.



4. The venturi should be cleaned monthly and flushed weekly due to calcium carbonate buildup for best performance.
